	Validity Periods – Detailed Site Plans	
For the purpose of	of temporarily extending the validity periods of certain approved Detailed Site	
Plan applications	s subject to certain permitting criteria.	
WHEREAS	S, the process of obtaining Planning Board, development review, and zoning	
approvals for det	ailed site plans is unquestionably laborious and financially burdensome for both	
private applicant	s and public bodies alike; and	
WHEREAS	s, as a compounding factor, approvals for site plans are impossible to renew and	
offer no certainty	of reapproval upon resubmittal once expired or lapsed; and	
WHEREAS	s, determinations of master plan consistency, conformance, or endorsement with	
appropriate regio	onal plans may expire or lapse without implementation due to the state of the	
economy; and		
WHEREAS	S, obtaining an extension of an approval pursuant to existing statutory or	
regulatory provis	sions are either unavailable or costly in terms of time and financial resources,	
and may be insuf	ficient to cope with the extent of the present delicate financial situation; and	
WHEREAS	S, despite evidence of a modest recovery in the national economic picture, real	
state developers, homebuilders, and commercial, office, and industrial developers continue to		

grapple with financial uncertainty in the wake of the recent national economic crisis; and

WHEREAS, the District Council approved similar wholesale extensions of all approved applications for Detailed Site Plans as well as Specific Design Plans in CB-67-2012, CB-7-2011, and CB-6-2010; and

WHEREAS, it is the purpose of this Ordinance to incentivize development projects with approved Detailed Site Plan applications that demonstrate certain steps toward construction and completion of the development project; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the provisions for the running of validity periods contained in Sections 27-287, 27-546.07, and 27-548.08 of the Zoning Ordinance of the County Code may be temporarily extended for a period not to exceed six (6) months in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions for the running of validity periods contained in Sections 27-287, 27-546.07, and 27-548.08 of the Zoning Ordinance for projects where a grading permit is required, the validity period may only be extended if a grading permit application is filed and accepted by the Prince George's County Department of Permits, Inspection and Enforcement ("DPIE") prior to the expiration date of the current site plan validity period. Notwithstanding the provisions for validity periods set forth in Sections 27-287, 27-546.07, and 27-548.08 of the Zoning Ordinance, a detailed site plan application approval for the project shall remain active and valid during the permit application review period by DPIE. The six-month extension period shall commence upon issuance of a grading permit for the project by DPIE.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions for the running of validity periods contained in Sections 27-287, 27-546.07, and 27-548.08 of the Zoning Ordinance of the County Code for projects where a building permit is required, the validity period may only be extended if a building permit application is filed and accepted by the Prince George's County Department of Permits, Inspection and Enforcement ("DPIE") prior to the expiration date of the current site plan validity period. Notwithstanding the provisions for validity periods set forth in Sections 27-287,27-546.07, and 27-548.08 of the Zoning Ordinance, a detailed site plan

application approval for the project shall remain active and valid during the permit application review period by DPIE. The six-month extension period shall commence upon issuance of a building permit for the project by DPIE.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the extension of the validity period for a given application shall only be applied to approved detailed site plan application that are in a valid, activity status pursuant to the Zoning Ordinance.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect on the date it becomes law.
