## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

The Listing of Local Questions on the 2008 Ballot

For the purpose of designating the order and form in which local questions shall be placed on the 2008 ballot and matters related thereto.

WHEREAS, Section 7-103 (c)(3) of the Election Law Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that the County Attorney shall prepare and certify the order and form in which local questions shall be placed on the ballot; and

WHEREAS, Section 1105 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland provides that proposed amendments to the Charter may be proposed by legislative act approved by not less than a two-thirds majority of the full County Council; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Council to prescribe the form and order in which local questions shall be placed on the ballot; and

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Schedule of Legislation provides that the County Attorney shall be the legal advisor and legislative draftsman of the County Council unless the Council shall specifically direct otherwise; and

WHEREAS, in each legislative act enacted by the Council that is subject to referendum of the voters, the language to be considered by the voters is specifically enacted as part of the proposed Charter amendment or referendum question; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has determined that the order of referendum questions on the 2008 ballot is a significant element of the Council's role to propose Charter amendments and approve other questions for submission to the voters by referendum and that the County Attorney should be informed and directed concerning the Council's determination in fulfilling her

1 obligations pursuant to the Election Law Article; and 2 WHEREAS, Section 1017 (c) of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland provides 3 that a resolution of the County Council has the force and effect of law of a temporary or 4 administrative character. 5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Attorney is directed to certify the order and form of the 6 7 questions to the local board of elections in accordance with the provisions of Section 7-103 (b) of 8 the Election Law Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland as follows: 9 **QUESTION A** 10 (CB-34-2008) LIBRARY FACILITIES BONDS 11 12 An Act enabling the County to borrow money and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding 13 \$9,155,000 to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, 14 improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation or repair of Library Facilities, as defined therein. 15 **QUESTION B** 16 17 (CB-35-2008) 18 PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITIES BONDS 19 An Act enabling the County to borrow money and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding 20 \$38,134,000 to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, 21 improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation or repair of Public 22 Safety Facilities (including Fire Department Facilities), as defined therein. 23 24 **QUESTION C** 25 (CB-36-2008) 26 **COUNTY BUILDINGS BONDS** 27 An Act enabling the County to borrow money and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding 28 \$112,596,000 to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, 29 improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation or repair of County 30 Buildings, as defined therein.

**QUESTION D** 1 2 (CB-37-2008) 3 PUBLIC WORKS AND TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES BONDS 4 An Act enabling the County to borrow money and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding 5 \$153,224,000 to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, 6 improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation or repair of Public 7 Works and Transportation Facilities (including roads and bridges, parking lots, and maintenance 8 facilities), as defined therein. 9 **QUESTION E** 10 (CB-38-2008) 11 COMMUNITY COLLEGE FACILITIES BONDS 12 An Act enabling the County to borrow money and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding 13 \$48,731,000 to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, 14 improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation or repair of Community College Facilities, as defined therein. 15 16 17 **QUESTION F** 18 (CB-12-2007) TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE SALES AND USE TAX 19 20 An Act to increase the sales and use tax on gross receipts from telecommunications service 21 within Prince George's County from 8 percent to 11 percent to increase funding available to the 22 Prince George's County Board of Education. 23 24 **QUESTION G** 25 (CB-50-2008) 26 PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT 27 To clarify the prescribed scheduling and notice periods for legislation by the Clerk of the 28 Council from five to ten days. 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any petition for Charter Amendment or for 30 referendum is hereafter filed that meets all requirements of law, the County Attorney is hereby 31 directed to prepare and certify said question to the local board of elections in accordance with the
