(a) Creation	
(1) There is h	ereby created and established a Board to be known and designated as the
Nuisance Abatement B	oard.
(2) The Board	d shall consist of seven members. There shall be a representative from the
Police Department, the	Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement, and the

- Fire/EMS Department. The other four citizen members shall be appointed by the County Executive and approved by the County Council to serve staggered terms of two years each. At least one of the citizen appointees shall represent the business community. Additionally, a citizen appointee shall be designated as the Chair of the Board.
- (3) Any member who fails, without an excused absence, to attend two (2) consecutive meetings of the Board, or six (6) or more meetings in any given calendar year, shall be considered to have resigned from the Board.
- (4) Any member may be removed by the County Executive, pursuant to Section 507 of the County Charter.
- (5) Citizen members of the Nuisance Abatement Board shall receive a stipend at the rate of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) per month. The Chair thereof shall be compensated an additional One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month for administrative responsibilities.
- SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
