**LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**

Fiscal Policy & Government Operations Committee                   Date: 6/17/92

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members MacKinnon, Bell, Del Giudice and Fletcher)

This resolution amends the labor agreement for Salary Schedule X, School Crossing Guards.

Highlights of the Settlement:

1. 6.5% COLA - 6/92-6/93.
2. No COLA in FY93.
3. Merit increase from 6/1/92-6/30/93.

Proposed Amendments:

1. On page 2, line 15, insert the following new language:

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this Resolution shall supersede the provisions of CB-13-1992."

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

This is a companion legislation based on renegotiation of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Prince George's County and Council 67 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and its affiliated Local 241. Charter Section 903 and Personnel Law Section 16-125(a) require Council action to amend Salary Plan.
