**RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION concerning

The enactment of a certain Ordinance of  
the City of New Carrollton

FOR the purpose of approving the enactment of Chapter 15, Code of Ordinances of the City of New Carrollton concerning storage of junked motor vehicles.

WHEREAS, the City of New Carrollton has the authority to enact ordinances related to residential storage and residential off-street parking; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, after a public hearing, enacted Chapter 15 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of New Carrollton on the 1st day of May, 1991; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance (attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment A, and hereinafter referred to as "the

Ordinance") enacts a new Chapter 15 to provide for the removal of defined junked motor vehicles from certain private property; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland Annotated Code authorized municipalities within the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District to enact ordinances affecting parking on land zoned either residential or commercial for the purpose of preserving, improving and protecting the general character and design of lands within the corporate limits of the municipality, provided that such ordinances impose stricter or additional limitations or restrictions than are otherwise imposed by County zoning regulations; and

WHEREAS, Article 28, Section 8-112.1 of the Maryland Annotated Code provides that such ordinance shall not be effective until approved by the County Council for Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Carrollton, pursuant to Article 28, Section 8-112.1 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, has delivered a certified copy of the Ordinance to the District Council; and

WHEREAS, the County Council, sitting as the District Council, has determined that the Ordinance imposes restrictions on residential storage, and design and height restrictions for garages in residential areas that are in addition to those currently imposed by Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Ordinance of the City of New Carrollton, as represented in Attachment A to this Resolution, be and is hereby APPROVED.
