BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of assigning certain existing classes of work to the bargaining unit represented
 4 by International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO, Local 1619 (Civilians).

5 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
 6 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has in order to
 7 provide better governmental services, recommended to the Prince George's County Council an
 8 amendment to the Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland which would add
 9 certain existing classes of work described in Section 1 of this bill; and

10 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
 11 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has
 12 recommended to the Prince George's County Council an amendment to the Classification Plan
 13 for Prince George's County, Maryland with respect to the class of work described in Section 1 of
 14 this bill, subject to an Amendment of Certification by the Prince George's County Public
 15 Employee Relations Board (PERB) and pursuant to the Collective Bargaining Agreement
 16 between Prince George's County, Maryland and the International Association of Fire Fighters,
 17 Local 1619 (Civilians) now, therefore;

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the Prince George's County Council of Prince George's
 19 County, Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is
 20 hereby amended subject to an Amendment of Certification by the PERB and pursuant to the
 21 aforementioned collective bargaining agreement as follows:

3318H Fire Inspector I, H17

(\$29,540 - \$49,504)

3319H Fire Inspector II, H19

(\$32,568 - \$54,579)

3104H Property Standards Inspector IV, H-22

(\$37,701 - \$63,182)

4734H Community Developer IV, H-27

(\$41,565 - \$69,659)

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law and shall be retroactively effective to July 1, 2001.
