AN ACT concerning			
	The Classification Plan for Prince George's County		
For the purpose of assigning certain existing classes of work to the bargaining unit represented			
by International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO, Local 1619 (Civilians).			
WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County			
Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has in order to			
provide better governmental services, recommended to the Prince George's County Council an			
amendment to the Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland which would add			
certain existing classes of work described in Section 1 of this bill; and			
WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County			
Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has			
recommended to the Prince George's County Council an amendment to the Classification Plan			
for Prince George's County, Maryland with respect to the class of work described in Section 1 of			
this bill, subject to an Amendment of Certification by the Prince George's County Public			
Employee Relations Board (PERB) and pursuant to the Collective Bargaining Agreement			
between Prince George's County, Maryland and the International Association of Fire Fighters,			
Local 1619 (Civilians) now, therefore;			
SECTION	1. BE IT ENACTED by the Prince George's County Council of Prince George's		
County, Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is			
hereby amended subject to an Amendment of Certification by the PERB and pursuant to the			
aforementioned collective bargaining agreement as follows:
