11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 12 Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional
 13 District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-107.01 of the Zoning Ordinance of
 14 Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code,
 15 be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

18 **DIVISION 1. DEFINITIONS.**

Sec. 27-107.01. Definitions.

(185) **Public Buildings and Uses:** Any land, "Building," or "Structure" used for public purposes by any agency, department, or branch of County, State, Municipal, or Federal Government[.]; but not including any vehicle or trailer parking, storage, or marshalling use which does not serve a public building or use in the County.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after its adoption.
