### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc. ("HIP"), a nonprofit organization based in Prince George's County, Maryland, has applied to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for approval of the "Front Porch and Façade Work Grant Program in Palmer Park" project for participation in the Community Investment Tax Credit Program. HIP is seeking tax credit allocations in the amount of \$25,000 to support its efforts to rehabilitate eight or nine single family homes that have been in a state of disrepair in Palmer Park, Maryland. HIP would rehabilitate these owner-occupied homes, and they would remain with their current owners after rehabilitation. The project would create suitable living environments by enhancing the physical neighborhood in a Priority Funding Area. Further, the project would focus on neighborhood revitalization and boost property values. The State of Maryland requires local legislative support for participation in the Program.
