PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 11/8/95

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Del Giudice, Gourdine, Maloney and Russell.)

This bill will amend the County Code regarding the Supplemental Pension Plan for General Schedule employees in order to comply with Title 39 of the State Personnel and Pension Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

The Legislative Officer had the following concerns:

- (1) Some of the amendments contained in CB-107 are contrary to the recommendations of the County's pension consultant, Mr. Bennett Shaver and consideration should be given to placing restrictions on the plan that are more restrictive than required by the state law.
- (2) Prior to enacting CB-107, the Council should determine exactly what amendments have been made to the Plan since the Council last incorporated the terms and provisions of the Plan through the enactment of CB-101-1994.

There may be some positive fiscal impact on the County related to the amendments to the County Code.
