**RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION concerning

FY 1992-2001 Comprehensive Ten Year

Solid Waste Management Plan

FOR the purpose of adopting the Prince George's County FY 1992-2001 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan as recommended by the County Executive.

WHEREAS, Section 9-515 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, provides that the governing body of each County shall adopt and submit to the Maryland Department of the Environment a County Plan dealing with solid waste

disposal systems and solid waste acceptance facilities; and

WHEREAS, said Code establishes a procedure governing the preparation and adoption of said Plan in Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, said Code provides that the County's Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan shall from time to time be amended or revised as deemed necessary; and

WHEREAS, on July 29, 1986, the Prince George's County Council adopted the Prince George's County Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan for fiscal years 1986-1995; and

WHEREAS, the FY 1986-1995 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan was amended with the adoption of CR-105-1988, CR-38-1989, CR-104-1989, CR-19-1991, CR-50-1991 and CR-43-1991; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive, upon review of the County's Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan, has determined that major revisions to the adopted plan are required to incorporate new information, data and policy directions; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has submitted to the County Council a recommended FY 1992-2001 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan to replace the adopted FY 1986-1995 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan as amended; and

WHEREAS, the County Council received public testimony

through a duly advertised public hearing; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the normal advertising procedures, the County Council notified the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission, the Maryland- National Capital Park and Planning Commission, the State and County Health Departments, the Maryland Office of Planning and the Department of Natural Resources of the public hearing on the Plan and provided each agency with copies of the recommended Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County Council held public worksessions on the aforesaid recommended Plan.

SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the document entitled "County Executive's Recommended Prince George's County FY 1992-2001 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan," a copy of which has been marked and identified by the Clerk of the Council and will be maintained as a master copy, is hereby adopted as the Prince George's County FY 1992-2001 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Plan.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the adopted Prince George's County FY 1986-1995 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Plan as amended is hereby repealed and superseded.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within five (5) working days of the adoption of this resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive by the Clerk of the Council.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution

shall take effect on the day following the first regularly scheduled Council meeting day which occurs after the County Executive transmits his comments on this resolution, or on the day the County Executive indicates he has no comments, or ten (10) working days following transmittal of this resolution to the County Executive, whichever shall occur first. Prior to the effective date of this resolution, the Council may reconsider its action based upon any recommendation received from the County Executive.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the effective date of this resolution it shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the Council to the Secretary of the Maryland Department of the Environment.
