RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Public Information and Community Education

3 For the purpose of establishing the Prince George's County Community Leadership
4 Institute to provide public information and community education.

5 WHEREAS, community leaders are called upon to make decisions on highly complex
6 issues with serious implications to neighborhoods; and

7 WHEREAS, the County Council appointed representatives to serve on an advisory
8 committee to advise the Council on methods to help community leaders across the County meet
9 the challenges of their role and empower them as community stakeholders to more effectively
10 make government work for them; and

11 WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee recommends the establishment of the Prince
12 George's County Community Leadership Institute: A Center of Excellence Empowering
13 Community Stakeholders; and

14 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute Advisory
15 Committee recommends a series of workshops to help community leaders enhance their
16 understanding of government operations and structure; and

17 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Community Leadership will feature a six-session
18 "***Know Your Prince George's***" pilot series of workshops covering essential skills and
19 information for effective and efficient community leadership; and

20 WHEREAS, the Prince George's Community College, in partnership with the County
21 Council will host the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute sessions, training
22 informed and responsible community leaders to address 21st century challenges; and

1 WHEREAS, the Prince George's Community College joins this effort as the education
2 partner for the Institute; and

3 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute will offer the
4 series of workshops to the general public at a later time; and

5 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, provides that
6 the Council may appoint, for designated periods, temporary advisory boards of citizens of the
7 County who shall assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
9 County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute Advisory
10 Committee is hereby established to evaluate and recommend to the County Council appropriate
11 workshop courses, and

12 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute Advisory
13 Committee will oversee the efforts of the Institute;

14 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute Advisory
15 Committee shall serve without compensation for a term of one year.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George's County Community Leadership
17 Institute Advisory Committee shall be composed of no less than 15 or more than 35 members;

- 18 1. Each Council Member shall appoint 3 representatives.
- 19 2. The Prince George's Community College shall appoint 2 representatives.
- 20 3. The Maryland National Park and Planning Commission shall appoint 1 representative.
- 21 4. The County Executive shall appoint 1 representative.
- 22 5. The Council Chair shall appoint 4 additional members.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George's County Community Leadership
24 Institute: A Center of Excellence Empowering Community Stakeholders shall begin its inaugural
25 workshop series on October 16, 2003.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator shall assign appropriate
2 technical and administrative support personnel to assist the Advisory Committee in its work.
