WHEREAS	s, community leaders are called upon to make decisions on highly complex	
issues with serious implications to neighborhoods; and		
WHEREAS	s, the County Council appointed representatives to serve on an advisory	
committee to advise the Council on methods to help community leaders across the County meet		
the challenges of their role and empower them as community stakeholders to more effectively		
make government work for them; and		
WHEREAS	s, the Advisory Committee recommends the establishment of the Prince	
George's County Community Leadership Institute: A Center of Excellence Empowering		
Community Stak	eholders; and	
WHEREAS	S, the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute Advisory	
Committee recor	nmends a series of workshops to help community leaders enhance their	
understanding of	government operations and structure; and	
WHEREAS	s, the Prince George's County Community Leadership will feature a six-session	
"Know Your Pri	nce George's" pilot series of workshops covering essential skills and	
information for e	ffective and efficient community leadership; and	
WHEREAS	S, the Prince George's Community College, in partnership with the County	
Council will host the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute sessions, training		
informed and responsible community leaders to address 21st century challenges; and		

WHEREAS, the Prince George's Community College joins this effort as the education partner for the Institute; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute will offer the series of workshops to the general public at a later time; and

WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, provides that the Council may appoint, for designated periods, temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute Advisory Committee is hereby established to evaluate and recommend to the County Council appropriate workshop courses, and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute Advisory Committee will oversee the efforts of the Institute;

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute Advisory Committee shall serve without compensation for a term of one year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute Advisory Committee shall be composed of no less than 15 or more than 35 members;

- 1. Each Council Member shall appoint 3 representatives.
- 2. The Prince George's Community College shall appoint 2 representatives.
- 3. The Maryland National Park and Planning Commission shall appoint 1 representative.
- 4. The County Executive shall appoint 1 representative.
- 5. The Council Chair shall appoint 4 additional members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George's County Community Leadership Institute: A Center of Excellence Empowering Community Stakeholders shall begin its inaugural workshop series on October 16, 2003.
