RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Prince George's County Green Business Advisory Board

3 For the purpose of extending the reporting date for the Prince George's Green Business Advisory
4 Board to review and evaluate the County's green business opportunities and to recommend
5 appropriate policies and regulations to implement a green business tax credit program in the
6 County.

7 WHEREAS, the Maryland General Assembly in 2009 enacted Senate Bill 403/House Bill
8 959 (Chapter 257 of the Laws of Maryland 2009) authorizing Prince George's County to grant,
9 by law, a real property tax credit for certain green type businesses; and

10 WHEREAS, Prince George's County Council on May 17, 2011 adopted CR-28-2011,
11 establishing the Prince George's Green Business Advisory Board, a seven (7) member group, to
12 review and evaluate the County's green business opportunities and to recommend appropriate
13 policies and regulations to implement a green business tax credit program in the County.; and

14 WHEREAS, the County Council and County Executive desire to provide additional time to
15 the Prince George's Green Business Advisory Board to examine the opportunities for green
16 businesses in the County, the impact on the residents and industry stakeholders of a tax credit
17 program and to consider appropriate recommendations for implementation related thereto; and

18 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the County Council or County
19 Executive may appoint, for designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of
20 citizens of the County who shall assist in the consideration of County policies and programs;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
22 County, Maryland, that the Green Business Advisory Board shall present its evaluation and

1 recommendations to the County Executive and County Council on or before February 1, 2012
2 and shall dissolve upon the issuance of their report.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be sent by the Clerk of the
4 Council to the County Executive and the Chairs of the Prince George’s County House and
5 Senate Delegations.
