Hamilton Gardens.	For the purposes of financing, rehabilitation and management, the three
developments will be	e jointly known as Regent's Square I, II and III (the "Project"); and
WHEREAS, C	DA received an application from Pinnacle Development Partners, Inc. and
Regency Developme	ent Associates, Inc. for tax exempt bond financing for the acquisition and
renovation of Regen	t's Square pursuant to its authority under Article 83B, Sections 2-201
through 2-208 of the	Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended (the "Project Financing"); and
