Dear Chairman Hawkins:

Prince George's County, Maryland (the "County") and the International Association of Fire Fighters ("IAFF"), Local 1619, AFL-CIO (Fire Fighters, Paramedics and Fire Fighter/Medics) have completed labor negotiations for a new labor agreement ("Agreement") covering Fiscal Years 2023 and 2024. Transmitted herewith for the County Council's consideration are the Agreement and the Council Bill necessary to enact the Agreement into law.

Also enclosed is a copy of the Resolution and Salary Schedule which accompanies the Agreement to be synchronized with the Council's enactment of the enclosed Council Bill. This Salary Schedule reflects the modifications contained in the Agreement between the County and the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1619, AFL-CIO (Fire Fighters, Paramedics and Fire Fighter/Medics).

Although the Agreement carries forward many of the terms and conditions of the County's previous labor agreement with the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1619, AFL-CIO (Fire Fighters, Paramedics and Fire Fighter/Medics), the new Agreement contains a number of modifications. These modifications are listed for Council in the enclosed ("Settlement Summary") for the Agreement.
