RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Arts and Entertainment District

For the purpose of approving the re-certification and continuation of the Prince George's County Arts and Entertainment District.

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2001, the County Council adopted CR-83-2001 establishing the Prince George's County Arts and Entertainment District in accordance with the State of Maryland's Arts and Entertainment District Program; and

WHEREAS, the County Arts and Entertainment District Boundary, which includes the areas shown on Attachment "A", consists of approximately 286 acres of commercial, residential, industrial, and mixed-use zones along Route 1, in the Cities of Hyattsville and Mount Rainier and the Towns of Brentwood and North Brentwood; and

WHEREAS, the areas shown on Attachment "A" were deemed eligible for designation as a State Arts and Entertainment District in accordance with criteria established by the State of Maryland and administered by the Secretary, Department of Business and Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, the designation of an Arts and Entertainment District provides for tax incentives to encourage private investment within the District to increase private employment opportunities, increase capital investment, and increase the tax base of the political subdivisions within the area where the District is located and surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, the Arts and Entertainment Districts Guidelines provide that the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development may designate an Arts and $1 \parallel$

Entertainment District for a designation period of up to 10 years; and

WHEREAS, when the 10-year designation period has expired, application and review for re-certification of a designated Arts and Entertainment District is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council supports the re-certification and continuation of the Prince George's County Arts and Entertainment District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County acknowledges that the income tax subtraction modification that may be offered in the District may affect the County's income tax receipts.
