RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The 2005 Water and Sewer Plan

3 For the purpose of adopting the 2005 Water and Sewer Plan and the 2005 Water and Sewer
4 Category Maps, and approving the fee schedule for administering Water and Sewer Plan
5 amendments, and the purchase of maps and related materials.

6 WHEREAS, Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of
7 Maryland requires the County to adopt a comprehensive plan dealing with water supply and
8 sewerage systems, establishes the procedures governing the preparation and adoption of said
9 plan, and provides for amendments and revisions thereto; and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to said procedures, the County Executive submitted to the County
11 Council his recommendations on the 2005 Water and Sewer Plan; and

12 WHEREAS, the County Council received testimony through an advertised public hearing
13 on the 2005 Water and Sewer Plan; and

14 WHEREAS, the County Council notified the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission,
15 the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, the State and County Health
16 Departments, the Maryland Department of Planning and the Maryland Department of the
17 Environment of the public hearing and provided each agency with copies of the 2005 Water and
18 Sewer Plan.

19 SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince
20 George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County 2001 Water and Sewer Plan, as
21 adopted by CR-62-2001, and amended by CR-9-2002, CR-36-2002, CR-56-2002, CR-65-2002,
22 CR-7-2003, CR-34-2003, CR-65-2003, CR-15-2004, CR-41-2004, CR-69-2004, CR-8-2005,

1 CR-43-2005, CR-75-2005, CR-7-2006 and CR-21-2006 is amended and replaced by the 2005
2 Water and Sewer Plan as shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that maps identified as the “Prince George’s
4 County, Maryland, 2001 Water Map” and “Prince George’s County, Maryland, 2001 Sewer
5 Map”, as amended, are hereby further amended and replaced by the “Prince George’s County,
6 2005 Water Category Map” and “Prince George’s County, 2005 Sewer Category Map” located
7 in Appendices C and D of the 2005 Water and Sewer Plan as shown in Exhibit A, attached
8 hereto and made a part hereof.

9 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fee Schedule is adopted as shown in
10 the Appendix 6-2 of the 2005 Water and Sewer Plan as shown in Exhibit A, and attached hereto
11 and made a part hereof.

12 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive and the County
13 Council shall determine that all proposed amendments are in accordance with the Category
14 Change Policies and Criteria as adopted in Section 2.1.4 of the 2005 Water and Sewer Plan as
15 shown in Exhibit A, and attached hereto and made a part hereof; and, any application may be
16 rejected if the policies and criteria are not met.

17 SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this Resolution are
18 hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph,
19 subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Resolution is declared invalid or
20 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall
21 not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs,
22 subsections, or sections of this Resolution, since the same would have been adopted without the
23 incorporation in this Resolution of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause,
24 sentence, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

25 SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within five (5) working days of the
26 adoption of this Resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive by the Clerk of the
27 Council.

28 SECTION 7. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the
29 day following the first regularly scheduled Council meeting day which occurs after the County
30 Executive transmits his comments on the Resolution, or on the day that the County Executive
31 indicates he has no comments, or ten working days following the transmittal of this Resolution to

1 the County Executive, whichever shall occur first. Prior to the effective date of this Resolution,
2 the Council may reconsider its action based upon any recommendation received from the County
3 Executive.

4 SECTION 8. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the effective date of this
5 Resolution, it shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the Council to the Secretary of the Maryland
6 Department of the Environment.
