AN ACT concerning

Emergency Transportation Fees

FOR the purpose of providing that the fees for certain emergency transportation provided by the County shall be established in the Budget Ordinance of the County.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 11. FIRE SAFETY.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Sections 11-346 and 11-347 of the

Prince George's County Code be and the same are hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 11. FIRE SAFETY.

DIVISION 8. [ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT (PARAMEDIC) MOBILE INTENSIVE CARE UNIT] EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION FEE.

Sec. 11-346. [Advanced Life Support (Paramedic) Mobile Intensive Care Unit e] Emergency transportation; fees.

(a) [There is hereby imposed a fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), payable to Prince George's County, on each person who is provided emergency transportation in an Advanced Life Support (Paramedic) Mobile Intensive Care Unit by Prince George's County. There is no fee for emergency transportation by any other unit by Prince George's County.] The fees for emergency transportation provided by Prince George's County shall be as established in the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

Sec. 11-347. Use of funds.

[Revenues from the fee imposed by this Division shall be used for operating and capital expenses related to Advanced Life Support (Paramedic) Mobile Intensive Care Unit services provided by Prince George's County.] Revenues from the fees imposed for emergency transportation provided by the County shall be used for operating and capital expenses related to emergency transportation, including Advanced Life Support (Paramedic) Mobile Intensive Care Unit services, as set forth in the Annual Budget and Appropriation

Ordinance.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
