The Committee of the Whole convened on September 23, 2021 to consider the appointments of Ms. Alicia Cotton-Doney and Ms. Michelle Rice, both residents of Upper Marlboro, to the Redevelopment Authority Board of Prince George's County. The Redevelopment Authority is established pursuant to Subtitle 15B. of the County Code. The Authority's goal is to stimulate revitalization in the County's older communities. The Authority's Board acquires land and property within the County for residential, commercial or industrial development or redevelopment of these communities.

Ms. Miriam Brewer, Appointments Liaison for the Office of the County Executive, introduced Ms. Cotton-Doney and Ms. Rice providing brief biographical information for the nominees. Both nominees summarized their background and qualifications to serve on the Redevelopment Authority Board. The nominees responded to Council Members' questions concerning their experience and vision to satisfy the responsibilities of the Board.

After discussion, the Committee of the Whole voted favorable, 10-0, in favor of the appointments to the Redevelopment Authority Board of Prince George's County.
