**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Enactment of Certain Ordinances of the Town of Edmonston

3 For the purpose of approving the enactment of Ordinance No. 03-003 amending Section 44-5 of  
4 the Code of the Town of Edmonston concerning residential parking.

5 WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Edmonston duly enacted Ordinance  
6 No. 03-003 on June 6, 2003; and

7 WHEREAS, this Ordinance (which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as  
8 Attachment A, and hereinafter referred to as the "Ordinance") amended the Code of the Town of  
9 Edmonston, Section 44-5; and

10 WHEREAS, Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland Annotated Code authorizes  
11 municipalities within the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District to enact ordinances  
12 affecting parking on land either zoned for residential or commercial use or adjacent to residential  
13 or commercial zones for the purpose of preserving, improving and protecting the general  
14 character and design of lands within the corporate limits of the municipality, provided that such  
15 ordinances impose stricter or additional limitations or restrictions than are otherwise imposed by  
16 the County zoning regulations; and

17 WHEREAS, Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland Annotated Code provides that  
18 such ordinance shall not be effective until approved by the County Council of Prince George's  
19 County, sitting as the District Council; and

20 WHEREAS, the Town of Edmonston, pursuant to Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the  
21 Maryland Annotated Code, has delivered a certified copy of the Ordinance to the District

1 Council; and

2 WHEREAS, the District Council has determined that the Ordinances impose additional  
3 conditions upon residential parking than those currently imposed by Subtitle 27 of the Prince  
4 George's County Code (the "Zoning Ordinance").

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's  
6 County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington  
7 Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Ordinance No. 03-003, as  
8 represented in Attachment A to this Resolution, adopted by the Town of Edmonston, be and is  
9 hereby APPROVED.
