For the purpose of proposing an amendment to Section 301 of the Charter of Prince George's	
County to establish voting procedures for Council members and provide a precedence clause in	
the event of conflicting Charter amendments ratified by the voters at the November 2004 general	
election.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,	
Maryland, that the following amendment to Section 301, Charter of Prince George's County,	
Maryland, is hereby propo	osed:
Section 301. Composition	n.
The Legislative Bran	ich of the County government shall consist of the County Council,
hereinafter referred to as the Council, and the officers and employees thereof. The Council shall	
be composed of nine mem	bers. In the event that a Charter amendment adding two at-large
Council member positions is ratified by a majority of the qualified voters of the County at the	
general election held in November 2004, then no at-large Council member may be a voting	
member of the Council. If, at the general election scheduled for November 2004, the qualified	
voters of the County shall	not ratify an amendment to this Charter adding two at-large Council

1 member positions, then this amendment shall be automatically abrogated and of no effect and 2 shall be deleted from the text of the Charter. 3 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act be transmitted to the 4 County Executive for publication and that a copy also be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors 5 of Elections for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters of this County at the 2004 General Election pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter. 6 7 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the question of adoption of this proposed 8 Charter Amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the General Election 9 occurring on November 2, 2004, and shall be placed on the ballot in the following form: 10 11 PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT\ 12 To establish voting rights of at-large Council members and to provide a precedence clause in the 13 event of conflicting Charter amendments ratified by the voters at the November 2004 general 14 election. 15 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that in the event that no petition for Charter 16 Amendment or for referendum hereafter meets all requirements of law and, therefore, is not placed on the November 2004 ballot, then this Charter Amendment shall not appear on the local 17 18 ballot. 19 Adopted this 30th day of July, 2004, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of 20 the full County Council.
