RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Drug-Free School Zones

FOR THE PURPOSE of approving certain maps as official records of the County.

WHEREAS, Article 27, Section 286D of the Annotated Code of Maryland, provides that certain maps or reproduction of maps may constitute prima facie evidence of the "drug-free zone" surrounding schools; and

WHEREAS, maps have been produced by the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission which depict the location and boundaries of the area on or within 1000 feet of the property of each public and non-public elementary and secondary school in the County that is used for school purposes; and

WHEREAS, the maps so produced have been approved by Executive Order and transmitted to the County Council by the County Executive; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends approval of the maps as official records of the County; now, therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the maps depicting the location and boundaries of the area on or within 1000 feet of the property of public and non-public elementary and secondary schools in the County used for school purposes, identified as maps 1 through 177, which have been filed with the Clerk of the Council and are incorporated herein by reference, be and the same are hereby approved as official records of the location and boundaries of such areas.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council shall be the custodian of the maps hereby approved and shall maintain the maps as official records of the County.
