FOR the purpose	of initiating appropriate zoning map revisions, by means of a Sectional Map		
Amendment (SM	(A), for the area known for planning purposes as the College Park US 1		
Corridor, describ	ed on the attached map and;		
WHERE	AS, the Sectional Map Amendment or comprehensive rezoning process is the		
principal mechanism for the public to implement recommendations of a master plan and to bring			
zoning into confe	ormity with a master plan; and		
WHERE	AS, the Prince George=s County Planning Board is in the process of preparing		
Sector Plan (Master Plan Amendment) for the College Park US 1 Corridor to ensure that the			
framework for th	e future development of the College Park US 1 Corridor is consistent with		
County policies;	and		
WHERE	AS, the District Council determined that initiation of a Sector Plan for the		
College Park US 1 Corridor can best evaluate land use changes, needs and trends along the			
corridor and develop new zoning tools to help promote reinvestment and redevelopment in order			
to transform the US 1 corridor from an old highway commercial strip to a revitalized gateway			
corridor and Ato	wn center≅; and		
WHERE	AS, the District Council specified in its initiation of the Sector Plan that		

appropriate zoning techniques to implement the recommendations for the College Park US 1

Corridor would be selected during the formulation of the Sector Plan; and

WHEREAS, the planning staff, working with an Advisory Planning Group composed of the City of College Park, The University of Maryland, the State Highway Administration, representative citizens, businessmen and property owners, has prepared preliminary land use recommendations for the College Park US 1 Corridor and is in a position to prepare a comprehensive rezoning proposal to accompany the Sector Plan; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the District Council to process the Sector Plan (Master Plan Amendment) and Sectional Map Amendment concurrently in accordance with Section 27-225.01.05 of the Zoning Ordinance so as to shorten the overall process and provide a strong interrelationship between the Sector Plan and the zoning of land within the College Park US 1 Corridor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George=s County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George=s County, that the District Council hereby directs the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to prepare a Sectional Map Amendment in accordance with the appropriate requirements of the Zoning Ordinance for that portion of Prince George=s County described as part of Planning Areas 65, 66 and 67 and known for planning purposes as the College Park US 1 Corridor.
