RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

State of Maryland Community Legacy Program

For the purpose of approving the application by the Central Gateway Community Development Corporation through the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for funding through the Community Legacy Financial Assistance Fund.

WHEREAS, Section 6-201 through 6-213, et seq. of the Housing and Community

Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, established the Community Legacy Program
to preserve existing communities as desirable places to live and conduct business and provide
financial assistance to sponsors for the development of community legacy plans or community
legacy projects; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-207 (b) (1) of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, provides that the Community Legacy Board may not approve an application for participation in the Community Legacy Program unless the application is approved by the political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the Central Gateway Community Development Corporation, a Maryland nonprofit, submitted an application to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for the Community Legacy Program and proposes a community legacy project that includes the rehabilitation and renovation of the Kingdom Square Shopping Center, formerly known as Hampton Mall, which is a commercial property bordering the Capital Beltway in Capitol Heights to improve and restore the visual appeal and condition of Central Avenue and the surrounding community of Capitol Heights (the "Kingdom Square Façade Improvement Project") as described in Attachment "A" and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the focus of the Kingdom Square Façade Improvement Project is to arrest continued deterioration, decline and disinvestment in the community through rehabilitation, renovation and beautification of a commercial property thereby increasing patronage and promoting neighborhood revitalization and enhancement to the community; and

WHEREAS, if the application is approved by the State, the neighborhood to be impacted by the use of Community Legacy funds will be Capitol Heights, in Prince George's County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive expresses approval of the application submitted by Central Gateway Community Development Corporation and its Kingdom Square Façade Improvement Project as a Community Legacy Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland hereby approves the application to Central Gateway Community Development Corporation titled the "Kingdom Square Façade Improvement Project" submitted to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Community Legacy Program in the approximate amount of \$800,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive, by his signature, expresses approval of the application submitted by Central Gateway Community Development Corporation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be sent to the Secretary of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for consideration by the Community Legacy Board.
