AN ACT concerning

Handicapped Parking Hotline

FOR the purpose of establishing a hotline within the Police

Department to receive citizen complaints concerning unlawful use of handicapped parking spaces.

BY adding:

SUBTITLE 18. POLICE.

Section 18-122,

The Prince George's County Code (1987 Edition, 1989 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 18-122 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby added:

SUBTITLE 18. POLICE.

DIVISION 4. MISCELLANEOUS POLICE MATTERS.

Sec. 18-122. Handicapped Parking Violation Hotline.
(a) The Chief of Police shall establish a dedicated telephone
hotline to receive citizen complaints of persons illegally using
reserved handicapped parking spaces for the purposes of dispatching
appropriate parking enforcement resources to ticket offending
vehicles and to educate persons who are in apparent violation of the
laws concerning the use of reserved handicapped parking spaces.
(b) The Chief of Police, in conjunction with the Director of
the Department of Public Works and Transportation, shall provide
that the hotline number shall be placed on each handicap parking
sign.
(c) The Chief of Police shall promulgate regulations to
implement the Handicapped Parking Violation Hotline on or before
January 1, 1991.
SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take
effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
