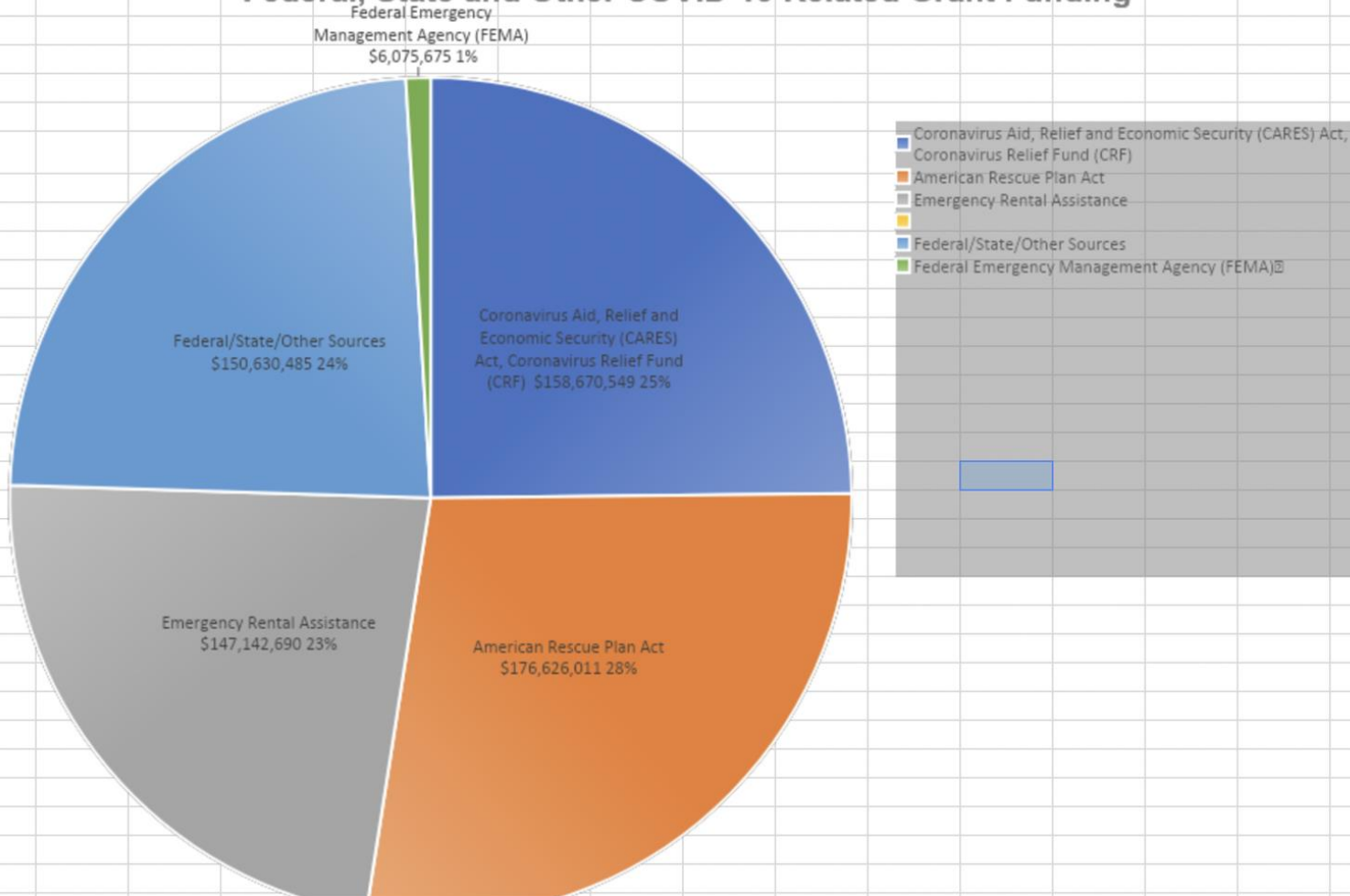


COVID-19 Relief Total Funds

- CARES Act Funds - \$158,670,549
- Funds Spent for COVID - \$176,626,011
- ERAP Funds - \$147,142,690
- FEMA Funds - \$6,075,675
- Other Grant Funds - \$150,630,485

TOTAL: \$67,126,142

COVID-19 Support, Outreach & Education

- Employee Overtime

- COVID-19 Impact Fund
 - Non-profits & small businesses were eligible to apply

Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

- \$147M County-provided rental assistance disbursed;
- \$662,000 awarded to partnering non-profit organizations:
 - Casa de Maryland (CASA)
 - Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc. (HIP)
 - Centro De Apoyo Familiar (CAF)
 - Sowing Empowerment & Economic Development, Inc. (SEED)
 - Laurel Advocacy Referral Service (LARS)
 - United Communities Against Poverty, Inc. (UCAP)
 - Mission of Love (MOLC)
 - Housing Options & Planning Enterprises, Inc (HOPE)
 - CLS of Prince George's County

FEMA - Grants Applied & Received

- Office of Homeland Security - Office of Emergency Management
 - 2023 Submissions: \$36,207,077.55
 - 2022 Submissions: \$12,045,757.59
- Health Department
 - 2021 Submissions \$6,049,379.50 (via the State)
 - 2022 Submissions \$6,666,030.02 (via the State)
 - 2022 Submissions \$7,442,569.77 (Public Assistance)
- To Date, the County has received \$6,075,675
