Prince George's County Planning Board.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
Maryland, that Section 2-112.07 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:
SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.
DIVISION 2B. PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY PLANNING BOARD.
Sec. 2-112.07. Planning Board; compensation.
The annual compensation of each member of the Prince George's County Planning Board,
other than the member designated as the full-time member pursuant to [Article 28, Section 7-111
of the] Section 15-107(b), Land Use Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, is [(\$19,400)]
Twenty-Four Thousand, Four Hundred Dollars (\$24,400.00), in addition to any salary the
member receives under Section [7-111] 15-108(a), Land Use Article, Annotated Code of
Maryland, as a member of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act shall apply to any member of the Prince George's County Planning Board who is appointed or reappointed after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
