7	building material in the construction of a building, structure, or development, a large, modular
8	standardized vessel used to convey goods by ocean or land transport, generally designed and
9	built for durability, and able to withstand weight, salt and moisture, in order to ship goods by
10	boat, truck or train, including those containers used by individuals and businesses for storage.
11	Includes Intermodal containers, Shipping High Cube and Hi-Cube containers, with standardized
12	sizes/durable closed steel boxes, mostly of either twenty or forty foot (6 or 12m) standard length
13	and common heights ranging between 8 feet 6 inches (2.6 m) and 9 feet 6 inches (2.9 m).
14	(221.1) Storefront Area: Land area within a "Village Proper" in the V-M and V-L
15	Zones, so designated in the village plan, generally for commercial use and upon which
16	commercial structures and "Storefront Dwellings" may be erected.
