to provide better governmental	services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the
Classification Plan for Prince C	George's County as described within Section 1 of this Bill; and
WHEREAS, the Office of	Human Resources Management, in consultation with the Health
Department, has determined that	at additional modifications to the Classification Plan are necessary
to support essential public heal	th functions by reestablishing the Disease Control Specialist class
series; and	
WHEREAS, creating high	ner-level Epidemiologist classes of work is essential in
maintaining the department's o	perational capacity, providing advanced analytical functions, and
ensuring the County is equippe	d to respond to evolving and increasingly complex public health
challenges; and

Classification Plan structure an	d the abolishment of one class of work is necessary as it is
