BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of reestablishing certain classes of work, adding new classes of work,
4 reallocating a certain class grade, and abolishing a class of work.

5 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
6 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has, in order
7 to provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the
8 Classification Plan for Prince George's County as described within Section 1 of this Bill; and

9 WHEREAS, the Office of Human Resources Management, in consultation with the Health
10 Department, has determined that additional modifications to the Classification Plan are necessary
11 to support essential public health functions by reestablishing the Disease Control Specialist class
12 series; and

13 WHEREAS, creating higher-level Epidemiologist classes of work is essential in
14 maintaining the department's operational capacity, providing advanced analytical functions, and
15 ensuring the County is equipped to respond to evolving and increasingly complex public health
16 challenges; and

17 WHEREAS, the reallocation of a certain class of work is needed to better align the
18 Classification Plan structure and the abolishment of one class of work is necessary as it is
19 obsolete, now, therefore,

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
21 Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is hereby

amended as follows:

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining

2 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
3 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
4 or section.

5 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
6 calendar days after it becomes law.
