REPORT: Favorable 5-0: Council Members Davis, Dernoga, Hawkins, Anderson-Walker and Streeter

CB-051-2019 will require the County to notify a municipality when it is notified that real property is being disposed of by any governmental entity (i.e. Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission, local, state or federal) The County will also be required to provide notification to municipalities when collecting fees or money on behalf of a municipality.

CB-051-2019 would essentially create a collaborative platform for governmental bodies to align regulatory requirements within the County, therefore potentially reducing duplication and promoting an effective centralized notification process.

During the committee meeting, Davion Percy, representing the Prince George's County Municipal Association expressed strong support for the bill. CB-051-2019 was also supported via letter from County Municipalities.

The Office of Law reports CB-051-2019 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The Office of Audits and Investigations reports that enactment of CB-051-2019 will not have an adverse fiscal impact on the County but there could be some indirect cost due to notifications.

After discussion, the Government Operations and Fiscal Policy committee reported CB-051-2019 out favorably, 5-0.
