DIVISION 1. GENERAL.					

Sec. 27-541.03. Car Sharing in Mixed Use Zones.

In Mixed Use zone development projects within a one (1) mile radius of an existing or planned Metro or light rail station or a major line of public transportation, an applicant may reduce parking requirements by up to six (6) parking spaces for each space designated for a car sharing vehicle by Memorandum of Understanding with a car sharing corporation or company. The final parking reduction shall be considered and established during the development review process.

DIVISION 1. T-D-O (TRANSIT DISTRICT OVERLAY) ZONE

Subdivision 1. General.

Sec. 27-548.10. Car Sharing in the Transit District Overlay Zone.

In development projects in the Transit District Overlay Zone, an applicant may reduce parking requirements by up to six (6) parking spaces for each space designated for a car sharing vehicle by Memorandum of Understanding with a car sharing corporation or company. The final parking reduction shall be considered and established during the development review process.
