For the purpose of establishin	g a Compensation Review Commission to study the rate of			
current compensation and allo	owances for Council members and compensation for the

accordance with state and loca	al laws, and generally relating to the Compensation Review			
Commission.				
WHEREAS, State and C	County law provide for the appointment of a Compensation			
Review Commission; and				
WHEREAS, Section 10-	-302, Local Government Article, Annotated Code of			
Maryland provides that by ordinance, a county may establish a commission to recommend				
compensation and allowances	for members of the county legislative body; and			
WHEREAS, Section 10-	303, Local Government Article, Annotated Code of			
Maryland provides that the county may set the qualifications, term of office, and				
compensation for the county of	executive; and			
WHEREAS, subject to S	State law, Charter Section 308 and Charter Section 406,			
require that the compensation	of Council members may be changed by an affirmative vote			
of not less than two-thirds of	the members of the full Council. Establishing not later than			
one year prior to the beginnin	g of each fourth year of a term, by ordinance, the Council			
shall establish a commission a	appointed by the Council and the County Executive to			

recommend compensation and allowances for members of the Council and the County

Executive. The commission shall commence its work at the discretion of the chair of the commission. Membership on the Council shall be considered a full-time position for the purpose of determining compensation; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-110.01 of the Prince George's County Code contains the current provisions for the compensation of the Council members and Section 2-112.01 of the Prince George's County Code contains the current provisions for the compensation of the County Executive; and therefor,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the 2025-2026 Compensation Review Commission was established, pursuant to CR-105-2024, and the establishment of the 2025-2026 Compensation Review Commission is hereby ratified, by ordinance, set forth herein, pursuant to Section 10-302, Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the 2025-2026 Compensation Review Commission shall consist of seven (7) citizens, three (3) appointed by the County Council and three (3) appointed by the County Executive, and one (1) Chairperson, who shall be jointly agreed upon by the County Executive and the Chair of the County Council.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the 2025-2026 Compensation Review Commission shall consist of the following seven citizens: Gloria Lawlah, Maurice Simpson, Jr., Steven L. Taylor, appointed by the County Council, L. Denise Hall, Arthur J. Horne, Jr., Jacqueline B. Woody, appointed by the County Executive, and Chairperson Camille A Exum jointly agreed upon by the County Executive and the Chair of the County Council.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that pursuant to Section 10-302 Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland and within 15 days after the beginning of the fourth year of the term, a commission established under this section, by resolution, shall submit to the county legislative body its recommendation for the compensation and allowances for members of the county legislative body.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that pursuant to Section 10-302, Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, the commission may recommend an increase or decrease in the compensation and allowances for members of the county legislative body, but it may not be less than provided in the county charter. The Council

may, within ninety days of the receipt of the commission's recommendation, by ordinance, accept, reduce, or reject but may not increase any item of the recommendation by a vote of not less than two-thirds of the full Council. Any change in the compensation and allowances for members of the Council shall be enacted by ordinance before the election for the members of the next succeeding Council and take effect only for the members of the next succeeding Council.

SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED pursuant to Section 10-303, Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland provides that the county may set the qualifications, term of office, and compensation for the county executive; and the 2025-2026 Compensation Review Commission shall study the current compensation for the County Council and the County Executive and shall make recommendations regarding such compensation.

SECTION 7. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council shall provide appropriate staff and clerical support for the 2025-2026 Compensation Review Commission.

SECTION 8. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appointees to the 2025-2026 Compensation Review Commission will also serve as members of the 2025-2026 Charter Review Commission.

SECTION 9. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 10. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
