REPORT: Committee Vote: Favorable with Amendments, 8-0 (In favor: Chair Burroughs, Council Members Adams-Stafford, Blegay, Dernoga, Fisher, Hawkins, Olson, Oriadha, and Watson)

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole (COW) on September 16, 2025, to consider CR-101-2025. Chair Burroughs summarized the purpose of the legislation. The resolution was introduced on Tuesday, September 16, 2025. It approves specific transfers of appropriations and expenditures within the Park Fund and the 2025-2031 Capital Improvement Program of the Approved Fiscal Year 2026 Operating Budget of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

The County Council adopted the FY 2026 Budget for the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission on May 29, 2025, as CB-055-2025.

Title 18 of the Land Use Article authorizes the County Council to amend the adopted budget by resolution, provided that before amending the budget, the County Council receives recommendations from the County Executive and holds a public hearing on the proposed amendment.

The current resolution proposes to transfer \$20 million from the Park Fund to the Capital Projects Fund to address capital needs in the County for the expansion or replacement of the Temple Hills Community Center (Project Number 4.99.0331).

A technical amendment was added to the resolution on page 2, line 12, to add the date the proposed amendment was transmitted to the Commission.

On motion of Council Member Hawkins, seconded by Vice-Chair Oriadha, the Committee of the Whole voted 9-0 in favor of CR-101-2025 (DR-2).
