REPORT: Favorable 10-0: Council Members Hawkins, Anderson-Walker Davis, Dernoga Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Taveras, and Turner. Absent: Streeter.

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on October 28, 2021, to consider CR-117-2021. CR-117-2021 is a resolution amending Salary Schedule "FO" for Fire Officials in the Fire/EMS Department, effective July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2022. This legislation is necessary to implement certain modifications to Majors' wages and other benefits in the Fire/EMS Department.

This Salary Plan includes the following modifications: merit increases, maximum wage scale adjustment, retroactive COVID-19 Hazard Pay for the period of September 27, 2020, through April 24, 2021, and a temporary increase of the maximum annual leave carryover for the leave year 2021 into the leave year 2022. In addition, a settlement summary is included.

The Office of Law reports CR-117-2021 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Policy Group reports that the adoption of CR-117-2021 will have a negative impact on the County in the amount of \$170,638.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted CR-117-2021 out favorably, 10-0.
