LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Committee Report

Committee Report: Favorable, as amended, 4-1 (In favor: Council Members Fletcher, Bell, MacKinnon and Pemberton; Opposed: Council Member Wineland)

Mr. Kahle reviewed the proposal and advised the Committee of comments received from the Department of Environmental Resources, the Office of Law, and the Audits and Investigations Office; and circulated a copy of a letter from Glenn D. Therres of the State Department of Natural Resources indicating that a bald eagle's nest had been confirmed either on or immediately adjacent to the Samuel S. Bevard, Sr. (B&B Partnership) property.

Mr. Kahle noted that he had discussed with Mr. Therres DNR procedures and guidelines regarding the location of such a nest. Mr. Therres

indicated that various factors are considered when a permit application is under review, among them are terrain, the nature of the operation and level of activity, and the timing of activities relative to the breeding season of the eagles. The Maryland Department of the Environment, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and the Corps of Engineers are aware of the nest and all of these agencies will be involved in the permitting process.

Several technical and housekeeping amendments were endorsed by the Committee as well as inclusion of a "Whereas" clause acknowledging Council's awareness of the eagle's nest and that its action on this Plan amendment is not intended to condone desecration of a sensitive wildlife habitat. Staff was asked to prepare an amendment sheet for Council consideration.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The Fiscal Year 1986 - 1995 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan, as adopted by CR-70-1986, can be amended pursuant to the provisions of Section 9-515 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Regulation 10.17.08 of the Maryland Department of the Environment rules governing the planning of solid waste management facilities. The resolution proposes to amend the plan to include B & B Partnership Rubblefill.
