### ZONING BILL

AN ORDINANCE concerning

Postponement of Council Actions

FOR the purpose of providing that the months of August and December shall not be included when calculating time limits required in the Zoning Ordinance for the District Council to take action.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

Section 27-291(a),

The Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland,

being also

SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

The Prince George's County Code

(1987 Edition, 1989 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-291(a) of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same is hereby repealed and

reenacted with the following amendments:

#### DIVISION 10. POSTPONEMENT OF COUNCIL ACTION.

# Sec. 27-291. Postponement of Council actions.

(a) Whenever the District Council is required to take action on or has the option to review a matter within a time limit specified in this Subtitle, the calculation of the time limit shall be postponed during the period that the Council is prohibited from taking action pursuant to the provisions of Article 28, Section 8-104(a), of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and the months of August and December when the Council is in recess.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
