**PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT** Date: 6/21/01

Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0, (In favor: Councilmembers Bailey, Scott, Estep and Maloney).

This bill will amend the Capital Budget by increasing the appropriation for the Resurfacing Safety Improvements project by \$3 million. The revenue in the amount of \$1.33 million is available from completed capital projects and \$1.7 million from underestimated State, federal and miscellaneous services credited to this project but not appropriated.

The additional spending authority insures the continued maintenance of the County's local road network and infrastructure resurfacing funds in the FY2002-2007 capital improvement program.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-38-2001.
