WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery County Council have reviewed the information compiled by the staff relating to spending control limits on the percentage of water and sewer rate increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council hereby endorses the following spending control limits for the Fiscal Year 2002 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission:

New Water and Sewer Debt: Sixty-six million dollars

Water and Sewer Debt Service: One hundred forty-one million dollars

Three hundred eighty-one million, six hundred thousand dollars
