BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Personnel Law

3 For the purpose of amending the language in Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code
 4 used to refer to the office, functions, powers, duties and practices of the agency known as the
 5 Office of Personnel and Labor Relations.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County
 7 Maryland, that references to the Office of Personnel and Labor Relations, the Personnel Officer,
 8 personnel actions, personnel practices, personnel offices, personnel forecasting, personnel
 9 administration and personnel management contained in the following Sections of Subtitle 16 be
 10 and the same are hereby changed to the Office of Human Resources Management, the Director
 11 of Human Resources Management, human resources actions, human resources practices, human
 12 resources offices, human resources forecasting, human resources administration and human
 13 resources management respectively:

4 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act is intended to make corrections in
5 the Prince George's County Code in accordance with the provisions of the Executive
6 Reorganization set forth in Executive Order No. 33-2003. Any provision of the Code remaining
7 unchanged and in conflict with the reorganization should be interpreted consistent with the
8 Prince George's County Charter and the reorganization.

9 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
10 calendar days after it becomes law.
