Committee Vote: Favorable/A 3-0 (In Favor: Council Members Toles, Harrison, and Turner) This Resolution will provide Supplementary Appropriations of Federal, State and other funds in the amount of \$12,339,190 for Fiscal Year 2014. The additional appropriations will support new and/or grant program efforts for the following nine (9) County agencies:

1. Department of Social Services	\$235,068 for seven grant programs
2. Office of Homeland Security	\$1,126,211 for five grant programs
3. Circuit Court	\$28,214 for two grant programs
4. Department of Family Services	\$791,359 for eleven grant programs
5. Health Department	\$2,450,479 for twelve grant programs
6. Police Department	\$375,000 for six grant programs
7. Department of Environment Resources	\$6,547,200 for four grant programs
8.Department of Public Works and Transport	tation\$784,809 for one grant program

The Office of Law has reviewed this Resolution and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The adoption of CR-43-2014 will have a positive fiscal impact on the County FY 2014 Budget by appropriating an additional \$12,339,190 in Outside Source funding. The grant awards will have an adverse fiscal impact on the County in the amount of \$1,413,545, but the additional revenue received from the grant awards far outweighs the adverse impact as a result of the County Cash.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

This Resolution will provide for Supplementary Appropriations for grant programs in Fiscal Year 2014. The adjustment to appropriations totals \$10,601,963 and will support the programmatic operations of seven agencies.
