### **REPORT:**

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 10-0 (In favor: Council Members, Hawkins, Taveras, Turner, Anderson-Walker, Ivey, Streeter, Glaros, Dernoga, Harrison and Franklin. Absent: Davis).

The Committee of the Whole met on January 28, 2021 to consider CR-7-2021. The Legislative Officer provided an overview of the legislation, explaining that draft 2 of the legislation as proposed by the Office of Law and was a departure from draft 1, wherein “Officials” were redefined as “public servants”. Draft 2 also removed any reporting requirements and clarified that “as a result of the insurrection at the United States Capitol, six individuals so far have lost their lives and many others were severely injured, including public safety officers”. The Legislative Officer concurred with the modifications as proposed in Draft 2.

Whereupon, The Committee of the Whole voted 10 – 0 to approve CR-7-2021 Draft 2 as amended.
