De	signation of the Patuxent River as a Federal Wild and Scenic River
For the purpose of	of supporting a request by the Patuxent River Commission for federal legislation
that will enable a	study to determine the qualification of the Patuxent River for designation as a
Federal Wild and	Scenic River.
WHEREAS	, the purpose of the Federal Wild and Scenic Rivers Act is to protect free-
flowing rivers wi	th "remarkable scenic, recreational, geologic, fish and wildlife, historic, cultural
and similar value	es" by linking local governments, private landowners, and nonprofit
environmental or	ganizations with state and federal agencies; and
WHEREAS	s, the Prince George's County Council has long recognized the Patuxent River's
unique and valua	ble wildlife, archeological and historical resources; and
WHEREAS	s, Prince George's County has preserved over 6,000 acres of these valued
resources along t	he Patuxent River as the Patuxent River Park; and
WHEREAS	s, Prince George's County has included a large portion of the Patuxent River
shoreline in its R	ural Legacy Area; and
WHEREAS	s, the Prince George's County Council continues to recognize the need to protect
the valuable reso	urces of the Patuxent River through its planning, zoning and development
policies and its in	nclusion of much of the river's watershed in the Rural Tier to protect large

preservation of rural character; and

WHEREAS, programs that add to our continuing effort to protect and enhance the Patuxent

amounts of land for woodland and wildlife habitat, recreation and agricultural pursuits, and

Rivera and its watershed are of significant benefit to the citizens of Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, it is believed that the Patuxent River, possessing high levels of natural and cultural values may qualify for inclusion with the many American rivers that have qualified for designation under the Federal Wild and Scenic Rivers Act; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such designation will in no way adversely affect the Patuxent River or the rights of the citizens and residents of the County; and

WHEREAS, a study of the Patuxent River, that is federally funded and implemented, is required to verify the qualification of the River for designation as a Federal Wild and Scenic River; and

WHEREAS, the findings of the study will be presented to State and local governments within the Watershed, and to interested organizations and citizens for comments; and

WHEREAS, the findings of the study will provide the State, the Counties within the Patuxent Watershed, and interested organizations and individuals with information of great value for the protection and enhancement of the Patuxent River and its Watershed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Council hereby supports the request by the Patuxent River Commission for federal legislation that will enable a federally funded and implemented study of the Patuxent River and its watershed to determine the qualifications of the river for designation as a Federal Wild and Scenic River.
