BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This bill is regarding the increase of civil penalties for off-road vehicle violations of the Prince George's County Code. Any violation of Division 19 of the Code shall be subject to a civil monetary fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the first violation, One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) for the second violation, and One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and impoundment of the off-road vehicle for any subsequent violation pursuant to the provisions of Subtitle 28 of this Code.
