A RESOLUTION concerning

A Public School Cell Phone Prohibition

For the purpose of encouraging the Prince George's County Public Schools to institute procedures to prohibit cell phone use by students in the public schools during school hours.

WHEREAS, students on cell phones during school hours create distractions from the necessary learning experiences; and

WHEREAS, prohibiting cell phone use by students during school hours can reduce the incidents of bullying and has been known to result in better grades.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Council hereby supports and encourages the Superintendent of the Prince George's County Public Schools to implement procedures to prohibit cell phone use by students in the public schools during school hours.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when such procedures are implemented that they be vigorously enforced with clearly established guidelines.
