RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Acting Executive Director of the Human Relations Commission

3 For the purpose of extending the appointment of Tuwanda M. Smith as Acting Executive
4 Director of the Human Relations Commission.

5 WHEREAS, Section 505 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, provides for
6 the County Executive to make a temporary appointment to the position of head of any agency of
7 the Executive Branch if such a position shall become vacant; and

8 WHEREAS, Section 505 further provides that such appointment may be extended an
9 additional four calendar months by resolution of the County Council; and

10 WHEREAS, by Executive Order No. 14-2004, Tuwanda M. Smith was appointed as Acting
11 Executive Director of the Human Relations Commission, effective July 1, 2004;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
13 County, Maryland, that the appointment of Tuwanda M. Smith as Acting Executive Director of
14 the Human Relations Commission be and the same is hereby extended for a period of up to four
15 calendar months from the date of this resolution.
