(a) The	ere is established a Commission for Children, Youth, and Families. The
Commission shall	consist of <u>eleven (11) voting members</u> [twenty-five (25) voting members.
One (1) member of	of the Commission shall be under the age of twenty-one (21) at the time of
appointment. The	Commission shall include the Director of the County Department of Social
Services or design	ee of the Director; the Health Officer of the Prince George's County Health
Department or des	signee; the Director of the County Department of Housing and Community

Development or designee; the Assistant Area Director of the Maryland Department of Juvenile Services, Area 5, or designee; the Chief Executive Officer of the Prince George's County Public Schools or designee; the Director of the County Department of Family Services or designee; the Director of the County Core Service Agency or designee]; one who will be a representative appointed by the County Council; one who will be the Deputy Chief Administrative Officer for Health, Human Services and Education or other designee of the County Executive. [; the Sheriff of Prince George's County or designee; the County Chief of Police or designee; the Director of the Prince George's County Memorial Library System or designee; the Chairman of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission or designee; the Director of the Department of Corrections or designee; a member of the Prince George's County Board of Education or designee; and the State's Attorney or designee. There shall be nine (9) citizen] The members of the Commission [who] shall be broadly representative of the community [and who may not be an employee of the County]. The appointment of members of the Commission shall be by the County Executive, subject to confirmation by the County Council, subject to Section 322 of the County Charter. The County Executive shall designate one (1) citizen member to serve as Chairperson [Chairman]. (d) Members in good standing, in accordance with Subsection (c) above, may serve on the Commission until their successors are appointed and confirmed. Members shall be eligible for

(d) Members in good standing, in accordance with Subsection (c) above, may serve on the Commission until their successors are appointed and confirmed. SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)

calendar days after it becomes law.
