Pamela Creekmur, Health Officer, introduced the panelists and expressed that Ms. Francis was absent due to her attendance of a ceremony at Buck Lodge Elementary School. Ann Keehn, facilitated a power-point presentation on the Primary Healthcare Strategic Plan for Prince George's County and responded to questions posed by the Council regarding: cardiac surgery capacity; Community Outreach Meetings; commute reduction; effect on other healthcare facilities in the County; health services/education for youth; and patient centered medical homes.

The segment on the Affordable Care Act/Connector Entity - Update and State of Emergency Legislation began at 10:48 a.m. Pamela Creekmur, Health Officer, introduced the panelists, Stuart Venzke and Dourakine Rosarion, who provided an overview of the Health Connector efforts to date (Handout - Briefing on the Capitol Region Health Connector to the Prince George's County Board of Health - February 4, 2014). Ms. Rosarion explained the intent of the emergency legislation under consideration by the General Assembly of Maryland and responded to questions posed by the Council regarding coverage changes and enrollment numbers.
