NAF supports operating expenses to community development organizations mobilizing housing and neighborhood reinvestment and implementing projects that result in the physical and economic revitalization of their community; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive, by his signature, expresses approval of the Project and expresses approval of the application submitted by Champ House Recovery Inc. to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development in the amount of \$50,000 in funding from the Nonprofit Assistance Fund for the Roof Renovation Project.

APPLICANT:

Champ House Recovery Inc. is a 501(c)(3) organization that provides group home and transition house services to men for the recovery from alcoholism and drug addiction. Since 1990, Champ House Recovery Inc. has provided services to men from a variety of sources, including but not limited to the Veteran's Administration, Circuit Court, District Court, Drug Court, Maryland State Health Department, Laurel Regional Hospital, Anne Arundel Medical Center, Hope House Rehabilitation, Reality House Rehabilitation, Pathways Rehabilitation, and Mountain Manor Rehabilitation. Champ House Recovery Inc. works with community groups including the Interfaith Council of Maryland which includes many religious denominations in the State.

In September 2015, Champ House Recovery Inc. purchased their site in Bowie, Maryland. They received a \$100,000 bond bill from the State, \$18,000 from Prince George's County discretionary grant funding and private donations for the sale.

In October 2015, Champ House Recovery Inc. received proclamations from the City of Bowie, the Prince George's County Council, the State of Maryland and the Maryland House of Delegates in recognition of their contributions to their community.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Champ House Recovery Inc. is undertaking a Roof Renovation Project at its' Bowie, Maryland site. This will greatly enhance its' ability to provide critical services to persons with addiction. The Roof Renovation Project consists of roof removal and replacement, and installing drywall, flooring and painting. Due to a badly leaking roof, this Project is critically needed.

New drywall needs to be installed. New flooring needs to be installed. Painting needs to be done on the exterior, interior and on the deck.
